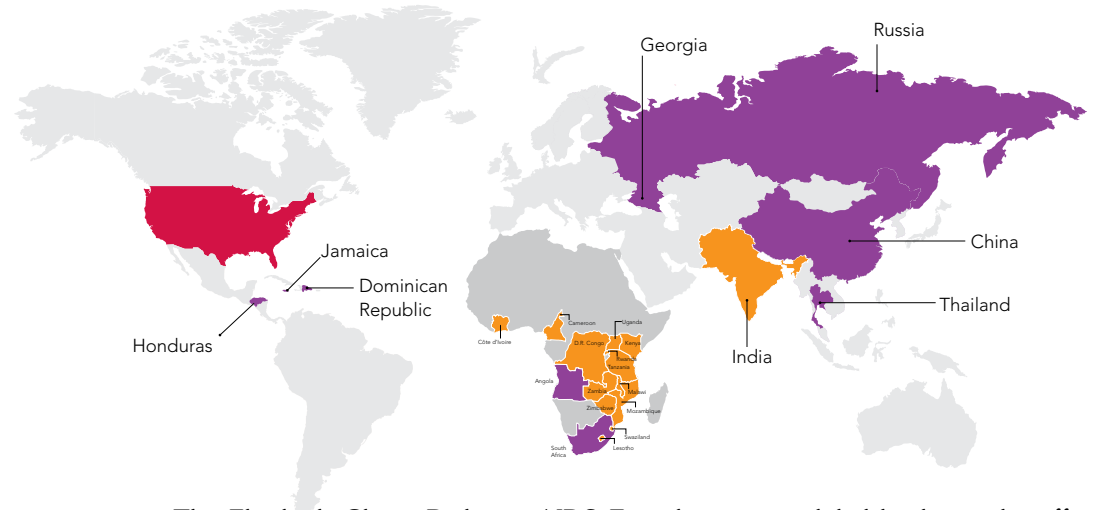




## International Programs
